Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the summer with your family. While it seems like we just ended school, it is time to start thinking about the 2017-2018 school year and Mountaineer athletics for the upcoming fall season.

We will begin our year with a pre-season parent and athlete meeting at 6:00 p.m. on August 23rd. This meeting will be followed by individual fall team meetings. All student-athletes and parents (regardless of season) are expected to attend. The meeting will be held in the Auditorium

The first day of fall practice will be on Thursday, August 24th. Football will begin conditioning on August 14th. All practice times will be released to the press and school website by Monday, August 7th. *As a reminder, all student-athletes must be registered and have a current physical on file with the school nurse in order to participate.*

In order to register, go to the Athletics tab on our website, www.hvrhs.org. Click on the REGISTER NOW button located at the bottom of the page. This will direct you to the FamilyID webpage. Once you have created an account, you may register for a fall sport by searching for Housatonic Valley Regional under Programs. We appreciate your cooperation.

In addition to physical eligibility, every student must be academically eligible in order to participate. Each student must *attain an overall average of C- (70) and must not have failed two or more subjects using Final grades per CIAC by-laws* in order to determine fall eligibility.

In addition to our eligibility policy, the CIAC is requiring that all students and parents be educated as to the signs and symptoms of concussions and sudden cardiac death. This will be done by using a consent form which is included as part of the registration process.
